In its 30th year as an ensemble, the St. Lawrence String Quartet brims with energy. They collaborate with today's composers — John Adams, Jonathan Berger, Osvaldo Golijov and others — adding to recent quartet literature. Dedicated equally to the music of Haydn, they recorded his six Op. 20 quartets and offered them as a free universal release last year. As soloists and as a chamber ensemble, their concert schedules take them throughout the world. The quartet takes joy in forging musical connections, directing the Stanford University music department's Emerging String Quartet program and coordinating with Stanford's schools of law, medicine, business and education.
